Joining the team

Assessment Day

The assessment day is your chance to be introduced to the team and find out if Platinum Ambulance is the right organisation for you. It is also our chance to meet you and ensure you meet our high standards. Our assessment days are at our training center in Horsham.

During our assessment days you will be provided with food and refreshments.

Here is what you can expect:

- 1. **Introduction** This is a welcome from us with a brief overview on what we are all about and what to expect throughout the day.
- Group Discussion This is our chance to see how you communicate within a group, you will be given a topic and asked to discuss as a group.
- 3. **Individual Interview** This is a face-to-face short individual interview. Please ensure you have researched the company and key industry regulations.
- 4. **ILS/BLS Assessment** You will work in pairs to conduct an ILS/ALS assessment, working to your skill grade. This is a pass/fail exercise.
- Clinical Exam You will complete a clinical exam of your grade. This is a pass/fail exam.
- Driving Signs Exam You will complete a driving signs exam. This is a pass/fail exam.
- 7. **Driving Assessment** During your assessment day you will take part in a short driving assessment that may or may not include a response drive. This will be conducted by a member of our driver training team.

If you pass all the above, you will move onto the following:

- 1. **Trust Induction** This is a local trust induction going through trust protocols, policies and procedures.
- 2. **Safeguarding** This is a face-to-face safeguarding session to ensure compliance around safeguarding our patients.
- Fit test You will be required to complete a fit test for your FFP3 mask.
- 4. **Blood Test** You will have some bloods taken to ensure you are protected against Hep C and Hep B.



What to bring with you?

Please bring ORIGINALS of the following documents on your assessment day:

• Enhanced DBS - (if already on the DBS update service).

- Proof of Address (within 3 months).
- Passport or Right to Work.
- Original Clinical Qualification.
- Original Blue Light Driving Qualification.

BULANCE

• Driving Licence.

What to wear?

Practical activities will require you to be able to move freely, so please ensure you wear comfortable clothing and suitable footwear. Please consider that you will be undertaking a BLS assessment and a driving assessment.

Compliance



Platinum Ambulance must ensure that each member of staff is NHS compliant.

- Enhanced DBS Check It is a requirement of your contract to maintain an Enhanced DBS check on the DBS update service. If you are not already on the service, Platinum Ambulance will send you a link to complete an enhanced DBS check. You will be asked to join the update service. At Platinum Ambulance patient safety is our priority.
- Referencing Platinum Ambulance require work history for the past 10 years. We must gain 2 work references and one character reference. Any gaps in your work history must be explained and evidenced.
- Driving Licence Those with more than 6 penalty points on their driving licence are not accepted.
 We will perform regular annual checks on your driving licence.
- Professional Registration Checks For registered health care professionals our system performs regular checks against the various registers available to check for any new information.
- Contract Specific Requests For several of our NHS contracts we must go through a 'PIN' request process. This process includes us suppling evidence of certain information to the trust to gain their approval for you to work on their contract.
- Right To Work We need to verify your right to work status by either seeing an original UK passport or immigration documents.
- Proof of Address We need to verify your address by seeing an original dated utility bill or bank statement, dated within 3 months.
- Clinical Certificates It is a requirement that Platinum Ambulance have a copy of your clinical and blue light driving certificates.
